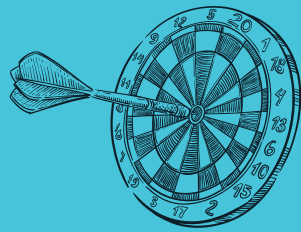

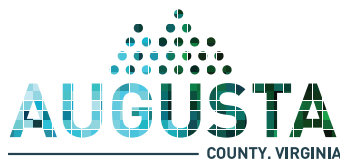
Check with Augusta County Government Center departments for business license, zoning, building, planning, engineering, tax information and more.
